

## Title IA – Improving the Academic Achievement of the Disadvantaged

The Weld Re-8 School District receives federal funds through Title I, part A, a United States Department of Education grant program that provides assistance to k-12 schools across the United States. This program is part of the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001.

These funds go towards programs at Butler Elementary and Twombly Elementary to raise the academic skills of all children. Both Elementary schools are considered 'Schoolwide' programs for these funds, which means that Title IA dollars benefit all students, and every student at these schools is considered a 'Title I Student'.

Below are some examples of the way Title IA funds are used at Twombly and Butler Schools:

- Reading interventionists who work directly with small groups of students who are having difficulty in Reading
- Reading, writing and math instructional materials and supplies
- ESL Interventionists who work with small groups of English Language Learners
- ESL coaches who work with teachers and students learning English
- A Math Coach who works with teachers in the implementation of the *Everyday Math* program
- Part of the salary of the District Parent and Community Liaison
- Help with translation services during Parent Teacher conferences and community events

In addition, Title IA funds are used for the mandated School Choice and Supplemental Educational Services programs.

School Choice has been offered between Twombly and Butler for the 07-08, 08-09 school years. This provision allows students at a school that failed to make the state defined "Adequate Yearly Progress" (AYP) for two or more years to attend another school in the district that did make AYP. All students at Twombly qualified to use Butler as a school of choice in the 07-08 and 08-09 school years. In the 2009-2010 and 10-11 School years, both students at Twombly and Butler Elementary schools were eligible for School choice. Letters were sent to all eligible K-5 families before the start of school for these years, and very few chose to use School Choice and attend Butler because of this NCLB provision in 07-08, 08-09, 09-10, 10-11 or 11-12.

Supplemental Educational Services (SES) are another program mandated by NCLB that requires tutoring opportunities from outside vendors for qualifying children in a Title I school that has not made the state-defined Adequate Yearly Progress for 3 or more years. Students who receive free or reduced lunch prices at Twombly in grades K-5 qualify for SES. Letters were sent home during multiple recruitment periods in the 07-08, 08-09 and 09-10 school years explaining the SES opportunity and listing the state-approved tutoring providers.

Students who receive Free or Reduced lunch services and attend Twombly Elementary are also eligible to receive Supplemental Educational Services free to the family in the 2010-2011 school year. Below is a copy of the SES letter initially mailed to Parents in September 2009 in English and Spanish and a list of SES providers for this year. Parents are encouraged to contact the providers directly or speak with Assistant Principal Scott VanLoo (303-857-7420) with SES questions.

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Welcome back to Twombly Elementary School! The federal education law, No Child Left Behind (NCLB) requires that schools in their 2<sup>nd</sup> year of school improvement or beyond offer tutoring to students in need. Twombly is in its 4<sup>th</sup> year. This letter is to inform you that your child may be eligible for free tutoring services. Listed below are important facts about the tutoring services:

**Who is eligible for services?**

All students from low-income families who attend a school in 2<sup>nd</sup> year of school improvement or beyond are eligible for tutoring. However, the district may not have enough money to serve all eligible students in which case the district will give priority to students who are the lowest-performing.

**Who are the tutors?**

The State of Colorado has a list of approved tutoring providers in your area from which to choose. See attached list for tutors available in our district.

**Where is the tutoring?**

It varies by provider. Tutoring may take place at the student's school or home, a local community center, library, church or neighboring school.

### **How much is tutoring?**

Tutoring is free for eligible students and will be paid for by the school district.

### **When is tutoring?**

Tutoring is provided outside of the school day. It depends on the tutoring provider but services may be offered either before school, after school, on the weekends or during the summer.

### **How do students get to tutoring?**

Parents are responsible for getting their child to and from tutoring services unless the tutoring group offers transportation.

### **Why should I consider additional assistance for my child?**

Tutoring services will help your child be successful in reading and/or math.

### **What will my child study?**

Students will receive extra help in the areas they struggle in at school. The school and the tutor will make goals for each student.

### **How will I know what my child is doing during the tutoring session?**

Tutors are required to send home letters throughout the program to inform you of your child's progress.

### **How do I choose the right tutoring provider for my child?**

First, identify the areas that are causing your child to struggle in reading and math. Not all providers offer services in both reading and math. Review the attached list of approved providers, the services they offer, the style of delivery (i.e., online, one-on-one, group) and the location of services if transportation is an issue. Choose a tutoring provider that has a program that you believe will work for you and your child. For additional help contact [person's name] at [phone number] and they will assist you in making a decision and signing up your child for tutoring services.

### **What if tutoring isn't helping my child?**

A parent may request a different provider if their child is not having success.

### **How long is the tutoring program?**

Your child is eligible to receive tutoring as long as his/her school remains on Improvement.

Estimado padre o guardián de estudiante:

Le doy la más cordial bienvenida al regreso de clases de la escuela Twombly Elementary School. La ley de educación federal intitulada “Ningún niño se quedará atrás” (conocida en inglés como- No Child Left Behind, NCLB) requiere que las escuelas que se encuentran en por lo menos su 2º año de haber sido identificadas como una de “Necesidad de mejoramiento” ofrezcan la oportunidad de instrucción particular a los estudiantes que lo necesiten. El propósito de esta carta es informarle que su hijo podría ser elegible para los servicios de instrucción particular sin costo alguno. Lo siguiente es información importante acerca de dichos servicios:

**¿Quién es elegible para los servicios de instrucción particular?**

Todo estudiante de familia de bajos ingresos que asiste a una escuela en por lo menos su 2º año de haber sido identificada como una de “Necesidad de mejoramiento” es elegible para instrucción particular. Sin embargo, es posible que el distrito escolar no cuente con los fondos necesarios para ofrecer servicio a todo estudiante que sea elegible. En dado caso, el distrito escolar les daría prioridad a los estudiantes con la mayor necesidad de mejorar su rendimiento académico.

**¿Quiénes son los proveedores de la instrucción particular?**

El estado de Colorado mantiene una lista oficial que corresponde a su área. Usted podrá elegir uno de los proveedores que se encuentra en esta lista. La lista anexa (o incluida con esta carta) tiene los proveedores disponibles de nuestro distrito escolar.

**¿Dónde se imparte la instrucción particular?**

El sitio o lugar donde se imparte la instrucción particular depende del proveedor. Se podría realizar en la escuela o en el hogar del estudiante. Asimismo, se podría ofrecer en algún centro comunitario local, biblioteca, iglesia o escuela vecina.

**¿Cuánto es el costo de instrucción particular?**

Instrucción particular es gratis para todo estudiante quien sea elegible y será pagado por el distrito escolar.

**¿Cuándo se ofrece la instrucción particular?**

La instrucción particular depende del proveedor pero no se ofrece durante las horas de clases regulares. Se podría ofrecer antes o después del día escolar, en los fines de semana, o durante el verano.

**¿Cómo se transportan a los estudiantes a los lugares de instrucción particular?**

A menos que el proveedor ofrezca servicio de transporte, cada padre tiene la responsabilidad de llevar y traer a su hijo a los sitios de instrucción particular.

**¿Por qué debería considerar ayuda académica adicional para mi hijo?**

La ayuda que reciba su hijo por medio de servicios de instrucción particular ayudará a que tenga buen rendimiento en lectura y/o matemáticas.

**¿Qué estudiará mi hijo?**

Cada estudiante recibirá instrucción adicional en las materias que más dificultades tenga. La escuela y el proveedor de instrucción particular establecerán metas académicas para cada estudiante.

**¿Cómo sabré lo que hace mi hijo cuando esté en una sesión de instrucción particular?**

Los proveedores de instrucción particular están obligados a enviarle cartas durante el programa para informarle del progreso que lleva su hijo.

**¿Cómo selecciono el proveedor de instrucción particular apropiado para mi hijo?**

Primeramente, identifique los componentes específicos que su hijo necesita mejorar en lectura y matemáticas. Tome en cuenta que algunos proveedores no ofrecen servicios en ambas materias. Repase la lista oficial de proveedores anexa para determinar los servicios que ofrecen, la manera de impartir sus servicios (por Internet, individualmente, en grupo, etc.), y en caso que el transporte sea un problema, la ubicación de los sitios. Seleccione el proveedor de instrucción que más le convenga a usted y su hijo. Si necesita ayuda con ello comuníquese con [person's name] al número telefónico [phone number] y alguien le ayudará con la selección del proveedor y la registración de instrucción particular para beneficio de su hijo.

**¿Qué sucede si el servicio de instrucción particular no le está ayudando a mi hijo?**

El padre del estudiante tiene el derecho de solicitar un proveedor diferente si siente que su hijo no está progresando.

**¿Cuánto tiempo de duración tiene el programa de instrucción particular?**

Su hijo será elegible para recibir instrucción particular siempre y cuando su escuela sea identificada como una de "Necesidad de mejoramiento".
